Training for Professionals and Agencies

Our training programmes enable professionals to gain an understanding of ADHD and associated comorbid conditions such as anxiety, depression, communication and language difficulties and anti social behaviour. Our aim is to give learners an opportunity to see ADHD from the perspective of those who live with and care for those with ADHD.

ADHD is explained using evidence based knowledge. Clear, practical approaches to its management are given to suit learners from education, health and other agencies working with individuals, young people and their families.

There is a great deal of misunderstanding about this neurobiological condition. Our training will help learners to clarify and dispel myths about ADHD, identify the types of behaviours associated with the characteristics of ADHD and enable them to make appropriate and timely interventions.

ADHD is the missing piece in the puzzle in promoting health, resilience, achievement and reducing dependency. Many professionals achieve outstanding results once they have identified ADHD as the root cause of challenges faced by their service users.

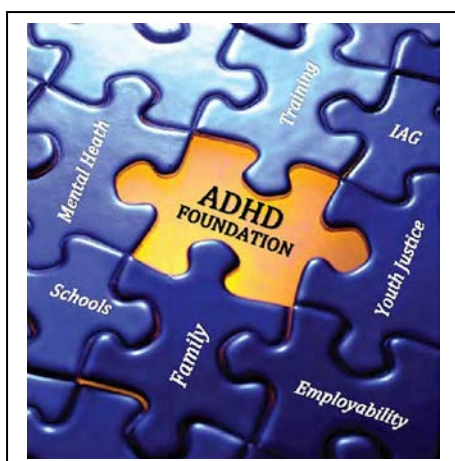
We provide a range of structured, tailored training for the full range of agencies working with people with ADHD.
