#### Who we are

The ADHD Foundation, based in Liverpool, is the UK's leading neurodiversity charity, offering a strength-based service for the 1 in 5 of us who live with ADHD, Autism, Dyslexia, Dyspraxia, Dyscalculia, Tourette's syndrome and other Neurodevelopmental Conditions.

# What is the Neurodiversity Umbrella Project?



- Every Umbrella Project installation helps to raise awareness and understanding of neurodiversity.
- Thousands of colourful umbrellas are displayed together over public spaces, in schools, and in company buildings around the nation.
- Each display is designed to represent the one in five of us who have a neurodevelopmental condition, such as ADHD, Autism, Dyslexia, Dyspraxia, Dyscalculia or Tourette's syndrome.

#### **Setting up your display**

One of the exciting elements of the project, is seeing the different ways people have displayed their umbrella's.

Top tips for displaying your umbrellas:

- Choose a space where the umbrellas can really stand out.
- You can use washing line wire/craft wire/fishing wire to suspend the umbrellas. Each umbrella comes with a hole in the metal spike at the top to allow for this.
- Some settings have also used carabiners to secure the umbrellas.
- You might want to ask children to personalise the umbrellas before putting them up for display. Get creative!


